Linda is survived by her husband, Bob Webb; her son, Billy Short (Ericka Olsen); her four sisters, Mary Anne Klipp, Josephine Geehreg (Bob), Nancy Sprenkle (Don) and Dianne Benko; and her two grandchildren, Everett and Quinn.
