Jerry was born on August 27th, 1943 to Carl and Marie Douglas in Texas and moved to Kingsburg with his family in 1944. Jerry had an older brother Darrel, who passed away in 2017. Jerry married Sandra Henderson in 1962 and they raised 3 boys Ronnie, David, and Johnny mostly in Kingsburg with some time living in Riverdale farming.

Jerry was a member of Local 701 Carpenters Union where he spent his career working on all aspects of the carpentry trade but specialized in finish carpentry. Known for being a commercial door hanging expert, he had an exceptional eye for detail and was a master craftsman. Jerry built his own home in Kingsburg and a beautiful three story cabin at Hume Lake.

Jerry's life changed when he accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal savior in 1974 at a small Baptist Church in Riverdale, Ca. His life focus switched from pleasing himself to serving his Lord. He was active in his local church as a teacher and leader and would also lead Bible studies in his home throughout his life.
