Leland Pendola passed away on Thursday January 13th, 2022 at the age of 94, in Hanford California. He was born to Robert and Marie Pendola on February 18 1927, in Visalia Ca. After completing his freshman year at Kingsburg High School he was needed to help support his family. In 1945 he enlisted in the Army and was stationed in Oak Ridge Tennessee.
