



Oscar Vasquez Murrieta

Oscar Vasquez Murrieta, a 56-year-old resident of Kingsburg, California, passed away peacefully at his home on May 11, 2026, surrounded by his loving family. Born on July 18, 1969, in Mexicali, Baja California, to Jose R. Murrieta Aguilar and Maria del Carmen Vasquez, Oscar grew up in Kingsburg and graduated from Kingsburg High School in 1987.

He began his career as a painter, working with Doug Canode for several years, and later worked for a company that manufactured tiny bed cribs for nurseries and orphanages. After a decade, he joined Beautiwood Unfinished Furniture in Fresno, California, where he worked until an accident left him disabled.

Oscar's true passions included camping, fishing, and spending time with his family, particularly his grandchildren. He also cherished moments at the beach, where he loved being surrounded by water.

Oscar's father, Jose R. Murrieta Aguilar preceded him in death. He is survived by his mother Maria del Carmen Murrieta Aguilar.

In 1990, Oscar met his high school sweetheart, Stella Gonzales Murrieta, and they married two years later. Together, they had two beautiful children, Oscar Murrieta Jr. and Mireya Gonzales Murrieta, and three lovely grandchildren,
