Peggy Sue Liles, formerly Rocker, initially Roberson at birth, was one of 5 children born to Clarence and Vera Roberson on February 23, 1960. She is survived by all four of her siblings: Sandra Wilkins, Diana Cloyd, Frank Roberson, and Floyd Roberson. She married her high school sweetheart Richard Ernest Rocker and had four children of her own; Stephanie Ann, Ashleigh Paige, Richard Nathaniel and Jarod Henry Lawrence. She has 6 surviving grandchildren; Simon Douglas, Atlas Kade, Lukas Edward, Hayleigh Renee, Killian Reyne, and Logan Jay.

Peggy Sue treated life like an adventure. She chose to soak up every experience with her grandkids that she could, as her days were filled with grandparents breakfast events at schools, soccer games on the weekends, and just a few days before her passing, she enjoyed her last night of play with

them, at the Caruthers' Fair.

Her family is broken-hearted as they contemplate the void of her absence in their lives. They share that they may not be able to tease her any longer for her innate ability to get lost (while following a map) or even to poke fun at her every year for celebrating "the (fill in the blank) anniversary of the year she turned 30," instead of a birthday, like everyone else. But they will undoubtedly each carry their love and laughter for her always. Peggy Sue loved to laugh and had no issue with laughing at herself, when the occasion called for it. She searched for beauty and peace in this world and found it each and every day.

She also had many friends in the community; People she met during her 40 years in the workforce. People she chatted with regularly on her social media. Even people she collected in her everyday life, just going to the grocery store or while gambling at the local casinos.
